## **NOTICE OF LOW PERFORMING STUDENTS BLOCK GRANT PLAN DISCUSSION**

The Low Performing Students Block Grant (LPSBG) provides funds for local education agencies (LEAs) serving students identified as low-performing on state English Language Arts or Mathematics assessments, who are not otherwise identified for supplemental grant funding under the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), or eligible for special education services.

As a condition of receiving LPSBG funds, the Lake Tahoe Unified School District is required to:

Develop a plan describing how the funds will increase or improve evidence-based services for the pupils identified to accelerate increases in academic achievement, and how the effectiveness of services will be measured.

The plan shall include information regarding how the services align with and are described in the district Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP).

In order to ensure community and stakeholder input, the plan shall be discussed and adopted at a regularly scheduled meeting by the governing board.

The meeting is called to convene at the LTUSD Board Room, 1021 Al Tahoe Boulevard, South Lake Tahoe, CA at 6:00 p.m. Any interested party may appear

before the Board of Education at the public hearing starting at 6:00 p.m. to speak to the proposed LPSBG Plan.
