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GENERAL COVID GUIDANCE - ATHLETICS

LTUSD has seen a significant number of students testing positive for COVID-19. This guidance provides direction on outdoor and indoor youth sports activities within LTUSD.

- All student athletes will participate in weekly surveillance testing in order to participate in school athletic activities, *regardless of vaccination status*.
- Face coverings are to be worn when not participating in the activity (i.e. on the sidelines)
- Face coverings are required at all times while riding on LTUSD transportation
- No sharing of drink bottles and other personal items
- Physical distancing should be exercised when possible

PROTOCOL WHEN AN ATHLETE TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

<u>COVID-19 positive persons are on Standard Quarantine- 10 days, no school or extracurricular activities. The</u> <u>student may return after 10 days IF symptoms have greatly improved and no fever for 24 hours. DAY 1 is the day</u> <u>after the onset of symptoms OR a positive test.</u>

PROTOCOL FOR CLOSE CONTACTS

(A close contact is within 6 feet for greater than 15 minutes to a COVID-19 positive person)

1. Unvaccinated/unmasked close contacts follow Standard Quarantine Protocol

(quarantine for 10 days without testing, Quarantine can end after Day 7 if a negative test is obtained ON or

AFTER Day 5 of last exposure)

2. Unvaccinated/masked close contacts follow Modified Quarantine Protocol

(Continue to attend school, no sports or extracurricular activities for 10 days. Quarantine can end after Day 7 if negative test ON or AFTER Day 5 of last exposure)

3. Vaccinated close contacts who are asymptomatic follow no quarantine protocol.

(A test is recommended 3-5 days after exposure, & monitor for symptoms for 14 days but do not need to cancel or refrain from regular activities including extra curricular activities)

It is very important to monitor your child's health. Anyone with symptoms of illness should remain at home

and contact your school nurse.
